In order to safeguard all involved we ask you to enter into an **Agreement of Partnership**.

**Ton YR YWEN PRIMARY SCHOOL**

**We will:**

- **Conduct sessions from appropriate locations within school or home.**
- **Use professional and appropriate language.**
- **Record sessions so that children who missed sessions can watch again\***
- **Share the link to live lessons to invited families only.**
- **Send the recorded lesson link to parents/carers of children of TYY only.**

**PARENTS/CARERS**

**I /we will:**

- **Ensure that my child is appropriately dressed for the live session.**
- **Never record any of the live sessions provided by Ton Yr Ywen Primary School.**
- **Never share any information about other children that may be included during a live session.**
- **Ensure that the live session is conducted from a communal room in the house (not bedroom or bathroom).**
- **Not allow any other adults (other than those with parental responsibility) to watch the live sessions.**

**CHILDREN**

**I will:**

- **Get dressed before I start my live learning session.**
- **Listen carefully to my teacher.**
- **Listen to my friends when they are speaking.**
- **Use kind words.**
- **Try my best.**

*\* recording will be uploaded to the school YouTube channel but set as private - only parents with the link will be able to access the content. Videos will be deleted every 48hours*
